These 90-minute sessions are organized by proposal submitters who are focused on the emerging technologies that are important topics to the ITS industry. These topics will be presented by thought leaders who are deeply entrenched in the emerging technologies.

WHO SHOULD SUBMIT A SESSION PROPOSAL?

If you or someone in your organization has recently completed a collaborative project related to one of our themes, the International Program Committee (IPC) invites you to submit your proposal. Your appointed moderator and speakers will participate in a session organized by you or your moderator. Only high-quality, relevant proposals will be accepted due to a limited number of sessions. ***Please note: By submitting a session proposal, you understand that these are not single-speaker sessions. They are moderated panel presentations/discussions.***

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- The deadline for submitting proposals is **December 6, 2024 at 11:59 PM EST.**
- By submitting a SIS/STS proposal, you or the identified session moderator are committing to organize the session content and speakers (if accepted).
- Proposals will not be considered unless the complete contact details of the organizer, moderator, and at least three (3) confirmed speakers are identified at the time of submission.
- SIS/STS proposals that address a single project will be given low priority compared to those that tackle a broad area.
- Diversity dimensions are considered for moderators and speakers. ITS World Congress 2025 diversity dimensions include but are not limited: race, ethnicity, age, physical and mental disabilities, sexual orientation and gender, amongst others. Proposed panels with single-gender makeup will not be considered.
